## Spanish Speaking Country Power Point Presentation Project Due: November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015

<u>Project Objective:</u> Design a Power Point presentation with pictures and information from a Spanish-speaking country designed to increase travel to the country. (Think travel brochure in a Power Point presentation style.)

Under NO circumstance should any words be copied and pasted from a website to your presentation. All descriptions/paragraphs should be in your own words. If it is discovered that you copied a description from another website, you will receive 0 points for that particular slide.

Slide 1: Title Slide 5 points

- Name of country
- Map of country that shows where it is located on the planet
- Picture from the country

Slide 2: General Information 10 points

- Write a 5 7 sentence paragraph that gives general information about the country. Your paragraph should give us an overview of your country. This should be IN YOUR OWN WORDS. If it is copied from another website, you will get zero points for this slide.
- You may include pictures, but they are not required on this slide.

Slide 3: Government 10 points

• Name of the type of government, name of current leader, picture of current leader

Slide 4: Flag 5 points

- Picture of flag
- Explanation of the symbolism of the flag design

Slide 5: Points of Interest 10 points

- Include <u>names</u>, <u>pictures</u> and <u>descriptions</u> of at least 3 points of interest. This can be famous landmarks, landforms, or other tourism spots found in the country.
- Include a map that shows the capital and other major cities.

Slide 6: Food 10 points

• Include <u>names</u>, <u>pictures</u>, and <u>descriptions</u> of at least 3 foods that are typically eaten in the country.

Slide 7: Holiday/Festival 10 points

• Include <u>names</u>, <u>pictures</u>, and <u>descriptions</u> of at least 2 important holidays or festivals that are celebrated in the country.

Slide 8: Sports/Recreation 10 points

Names, pictures, and descriptions of at least 3 sports or types of recreation enjoyed in your country

Slide 9: Famous People 10 points

• Include <u>names</u>, <u>pictures</u>, and <u>descriptions</u> of at least 2 significant people who are from or live in the country.

Slide 10: Student Choice 10 points

- As you are researching your country, keep your eyes open for other interesting information that does not fit into a category that I've listed above. You get to pick what goes on this slide.
- It must include at 1 picture and description of whatever you decide.

Slide 11: Citation Slide 10 points

- All pictures and information in the presentation should be cited on this page.
- The citations should be organized by slides. Mrs. Martin will show you this better in class.
- All text should be uniform on this slide. If one link is hyperlinked, all should be hyperlinked.

## Additional information:

Pictures should not be stretched to where they appear distorted.

All fonts should be uniform throughout the presentation. Header text can be fancy, but everything else should be a standard type of text and the same on each slide.
